Kindergarten Weekly Spelling Lists What's Included?


<u>Spelling Fest Paper:</u> Use to check what words your kids know. But remember don't go overboard with grading. Partner grade or grade their own with a crayon after (so you can see who does not have the correct answer in pencil!)






Master Spelling List: This is the one I send home to my parents. It gives the parents the vocabulary for the spelling words... Red means stop and think and Green means go ahead and sound it out!

Classroom Spelling List: This is the one we hang up in class. It has less words on it and the kids can focus on it. I also put these lists in the students "I'm bored" folders so they can practice when they have a minute or two. I also outline the words with crayon or marker.





Mini Spelling Lists: I use these to send home the day before our 'test' or in centers.

<u>Pocket Chart Cards/Flashcards:</u> Just what they say... for your pocket chart. Print red ones on red paper (underlined words) and green words on green paper! They can also be used to send home as flashcards!





<u>Large Wall Cards</u>: Large posters of words for your wall or other activities.

Rainbow Word Cards or Play Dough Mats: Laminate and use as play dough mats OR print and use as giant rainbow words.



<u>Various Worksheets:</u> Lots-o-options to use in class. Elkonin Box Writing, Rainbow Writing, Read it — Write it — Glue/Stamp It, and other word practice pages.
