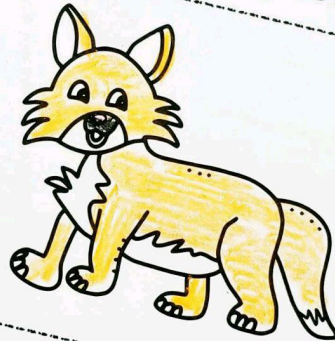

Hedgehog



Hedgehogs are only found in some parts of the world. They are nocturnal, which means that they sleep during the day and are awake at night. Hedgehogs eat things like insects, snails, frog, grass, and berries. Hedgehogs have spines over most of their bodies. These spines are not easily removed like those on porcupines. To protect itself, a hedgehog rolls into a ball which makes those spines spike out.
